MEMORANDUM FOR THE STANDING GROUP

SUBJECT: Establishment of a Military Higher Direction Exercise Working Group for FALLEX-66

Reference: MCM-22-66, 1 March 1966

1. At its 206th Meeting, the Military Committee (MC) approved the reference which provided for the formation and Terms of Reference of a Military Higher Direction (MHD) Exercise Working Group (WG) for FALLEX-66 responsible to the Standing Group (SGN) in its capacity as executive agent for the MC, through the Director of the International Planning Staff (IPS).

2. Accordingly, the purpose of this memorandum is to inform the SGN of the establishment of the FALLEX-66 WG and also of its composition which is at Enclosure.

3. During the process of organizing the WG, laying out its planning schedule, and planning for MHD participation in FALLEX-66, the Chairman will call such conferences and issue such informal Exercise WG Memoranda as is necessary for the proper functioning of the Group, keeping the SGN and the MC informed on significant matters. Further, the WG will be called upon to prepare progress reports and/or briefing to the MHD as necessary.
