SUBJECT: ACP 190 - Guide to Frequency Planning

1. Forwarded separately, this date, in accordance with paragraph 202 b of reference b, are advance copies of ACP 190, a new ACP approved by reference a for NATO use.

2. Bulk distribution of ACP 190 is being initiated concurrently. The NATO nations are requested to advise the Standing Group upon receipt of bulk distribution. The NATO nations are further requested to advise their respective distributing authorities (paragraph 204 of reference b) to initiate tracer action if bulk distribution is not in accordance with requirements reported to the Standing Group. For the purpose of this action, it should be assumed that the first group of copies received from the distributing authorities are all that will be received unless this action is taken. The Standing Group should be advised by the NATO nations of any such action in this regard.

4. ACP 190 will be implemented concurrently with ACP 190 NATO SUPP-1, when directed. A target date for their implementation will be established when ACP 190 NATO SUPP-1 is available.

5. Where there is a conflict between basic ACP 190 and ACP 190 NATO SUPP-1, the instructions in ACP 190 NATO SUPP-1 will take precedence.

6. This memorandum will be cancelled when ACP 190 is implemented, in accordance with paragraph 4 above.
