MEMORANDUM FOR THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER ATLANTIC

SUBJECT: Naval Control of Shipping - Ports of Entry

1. By reference b SACLANT was invited to make proposals for the revision or updating of MC documents mostly dealing with Naval Control of Shipping matters. The proposed action is listed in reference c.

2. As far as MRC 7/1 - Naval Control of Merchant Shipping - is concerned it was suggested in reference c, paragraph 10.b, that MOD UK should be asked whether Aden is still viable as a Port of Entry.

3. The United Kingdom Military Representative to the Military Committee recently informed the International Military Staff of the position of Aden as a Port of Entry. This information is at Enclosure.

4. A proposal to change reference a accordingly will be prepared by the International Military Staff.
