

**Subject:** NADGE Project

1. The NADGE Policy Board examined the situation resulting from the non-submission by Consortia of price bids for the implementation of the NADGE Project.
2. After exploring various possibilities of covering the gap between costs and available funds the NADGE Policy Board agreed, subject to confirmation by the United Kingdom, to reduce the scope of the project. This was done, on the basis of guidance contained in subpara (2) of para 44 of document C-R(64)34, by a new determination in common by the military authorities of NATO and national military authorities, of certain reductions in the Project.
3. Since these reductions require some additional time for obtaining new bids, the date of 31st March 1966, laid down in para 44 of document C-R(65)45 has now to be moved to 30th June, 1966.
4. The NADGE Policy Board therefore recommends that the Council
  - a) take note of the action of the NADGE Policy Board mentioned in 2. above
  - b) approve the extension of the deadline mentioned in para 44 of document C-R(65)45 to 30th June, 1966 and to amend document C-M(63)91 accordingly.
