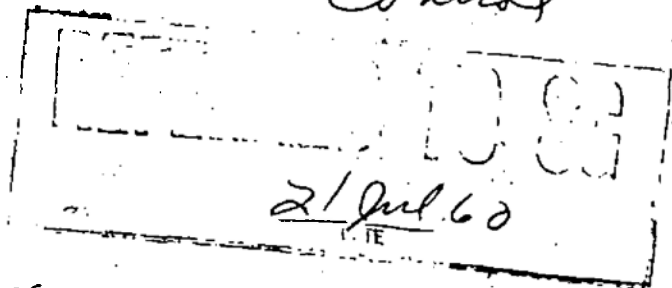



1        1. The procedures described herein will be followed  
 2 during the preparation of the military portion of the 1960  
 3 Annual Review Report.

4        2. The Annual Review International Planning Team (AR IPT)  
 5 will submit a series of reports (IPT 98 Series) to the Standing  
 6 Group on Military Comments, Recommendations and the military  
 7 portion of the Country Summary Appraisals. A separate memo-  
 8 randum will be prepared on each country. Each will enclose:

9            a. A draft memorandum (SGM) to the Standing Group  
 10        Representative, with information copies to the Major  
 11        NATO Commanders. SGREP will distribute copies to the  
 12        International Staff and to the delegation of the country  
 13        concerned immediately on receipt, and to all other country  
 14        delegations approximately 30 days prior to the examining  
 15        session of the country concerned. SGREP will notify  
 16        the SGN of the date on which he releases copies to all  
 17        delegations so that simultaneous distribution may be  
 18        made to all Military Representatives in Washington.

19        This memorandum will contain the following information:

20            (1) Enclosure 1 to the memorandum. This will  
 21        consist of Commanders' comments. quoted verbatim,

1 and Standing Group comments where appropriate. The  
2 Standing Group will take note of the Commanders'  
3 comments and approve the Standing Group portion, if  
4 one is necessary;

5 (2) Enclosure 2 to the memorandum. This will  
6 consist of the final list of military recommendations,  
7 prepared by the Standing Group, based upon the pro-  
8 visional list of recommendations provided by the  
9 Commanders, and reconciled by the Standing Group.  
10 This Enclosure will also serve as an enclosure to  
11 the Country Chapter.

12 b. A second draft memorandum (SGM) to the Standing  
13 Group Representative containing the military portion of  
14 the Country Chapters, and the military portion of the  
15 country summary appraisal, both prepared by the Standing  
16 Group. This memorandum will be sent to the Standing  
17 Group Representative, with copies for the International  
18 Staff, and:

19 (1) The Standing Group Representative, together  
20 with the International Staff, will provide the  
21 necessary tables;

22 (2) Neither the Standing Group Representative  
23 nor the International Staff will be authorized to  
24 change the substance of this document except with  
25 the authority of the Standing Group. However, SGREP  
26 will be authorized to make such drafting changes as  
27 are required to insure compatibility with the balance  
28 of the Country Chapters;

1           (3) The Country Chapter (excepting military  
2           portion thereof) will be prepared by the Inter-  
3           national Staff. The military portion of the chapter it-  
4           self, and of the country summary appraisal, will be  
5           provided by the Standing Group.

6           3. The basic documents for all reports will be MC 70 and  
7           MC 55/1.

8           4. The Standing Group Representative and the International  
9           Staff, in adding tables as required to the military portion of  
10          the Annual Review, will use MC 70 data, except where the Standing  
11          Group has authorized deviations therefrom (reference d refers).  
12          The Standing Group Representative should, by footnotes, indicate  
13          on the force tables for each country concerned such modifications.
