MEMORANDUM FOR THE **TURKISH** DELEGATION (Attention **M.R. Akinci**)

SUBJECT: Annual Review - Further Examination of Tables  
12 for Army Equipment

1. In AC/19-D/48 it has been suggested that a further examination of certain Tables 12 for Army Equipment should take place and that country representatives should come to the Palais de Chaillot for a discussion, and if necessary a revision of the present Tables 12.

2. I should like to propose the 2nd and 3rd of March as the dates for the examination of the Turkish Tables 12 for Army Equipment and I would be grateful if you would let me know at the earliest possible moment whether these dates are convenient to you.

3. It is realised that the time between the receipt of the SHAPE proposals as to equipment levels and the examination of your Tables 12 will be rather short, but it seems undesirable to defer the examination if the Report for the Council is to be ready by the agreed time.

4. May I draw your attention to the points for discussion set out in Annex B to AC/19-D/48 and also to the list of items at Annex A, as supplemented by paragraph 5 of that Document.

5. At a convenient time I would be grateful if you would let me know the names and appointments of your proposed representatives.
