MEMORANDUM FOR EUROPEAN MILITARY COMMITTEE FOR THE COORDINATION OF
COMMUNICATIONS (E.M.C.C.C.)SUBJECT: Control of Radio Transmitters in Time of War
or Emergency

1. Standing Group have had under discussion the question of an integrated plan for the control of radio transmitters in time of war or emergency and certain preliminary steps have been taken by the Communications-Electronics Coordination Section of the Standing Group.


