MEMORANDUM FOR THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER EUROPE

SUBJECT: Implementation of SGM-487-51 (Channels for Transmission of Warning of Attack)

1. For your information in connection with implementation of the plan contained in SGM-487-51, you are advised that the following countries have signified their concurrence in SGM-487-51 and have designated the indicated agencies as authorized to transmit warning messages to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization:

- Canada The Canadian Chiefs of Staff
- Denmark The Commander-in-Chief, Danish Armed Forces
- France Etat-Major Combine des Forces Armées
- Italy The Italian General Staff
- The Netherlands The Netherlands Chiefs of Staff
- Norway The Norwegian Joint Defense Staff
- Portugal The Portuguese Minister of National Defense or the Portuguese Chief of Staff
- United Kingdom United Kingdom Chiefs of Staff Committee
- United States United States Joint Chiefs of Staff
