SUBJECT: Release of Canadian Equipment  
to NATO - Revised Phase III

Further to SGM-1211-51, the Standing Group has been advised that the Canadian Government approve the allocation to Italy of the following guns and ammunition which are surplus to Canadian requirements in Korea:

- a. 24 equipments Q.F. 17 pr. A Tk (Towed)  
with maintenance spares
- b. 25 equipments Q.F. 17 pr. A Tk (Self-Propelled) with maintenance spares
- c. 8,370 rounds of 17 pr. ammunition,  
including:
  - (1) H.E. 1000
  - (2) APCBC 6970
  - (3) Smoke 400
