MEMORANDUM FOR THE DANISH MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Allocation of Canadian Equipment -  
Phase III (Revised)

1. The Standing Group forwarded recommendations to the Canadian Government as to the allocation of the 17 pr. A Tk Guns and ammunition offered to NATO nations after March 1952. The Danish bid for these equipments as outlined in AF 149/7-13, dated 16 July 1951, was considered when these recommendations were formulated.

2. In reply, the Standing Group has been informed that the Canadian Government would prefer to defer approval of the Standing Group recommended allocation of the A Tk Guns until the allocation of other equipment becoming available after March 1952 has been made.

3. Further information will be forwarded as soon as it is available.
