MEMORANDUM FOR THE CANADIAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Recommended Allocation of the Balance of the AA Ammunition Offered to NATO Nations by the Canadian Government

Reference: SGM-1415-51

1. The Standing Group has been informed that the United Kingdom are prepared to offer 77,000 rounds 3.7" H.E. ammunition fuze 214 in exchange for the 77,000 rounds 3.7" H.E. ammunition plugged for V.T. fuzes offered by the Canadian Government.

2. The Standing Group recommend that the United Kingdom offer be accepted and that the ammunition fuze 214 be allotted to nations in proportion to the allocation of guns recommended in SGM-1415-51, as follows:

- France - 46,200 rounds
- Italy - 12,320 rounds
- Netherlands - 12,320 rounds
- Portugal - 6,160 rounds

3. The comments of the Canadian Government on the above recommendations are requested.
