TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR STANDING GROUP LIAISON OFFICER
TO THE TEMPORARY COUNCIL COMMITTEE

1. The Standing Group Liaison Officer to the Temporary Council Committee and subordinate agencies will be a member of the staff of the Standing Group while serving in that capacity.
2. The Standing Group Liaison Officer is appointed with a dual object. He will present the approved positions of the Standing Group to the TCC and its subordinate agency, the Screening and Costing Committee (SCC), and will keep the Standing Group informed on those matters of interest to them which are under consideration by the TCC (or SCC), or likely to be considered by them and especially of those matters which are dealt with by the TCC (or SCC) directly with NATO Commands or agencies subordinate to the Standing Group.
3. The Liaison Officer to the TCC (SCC) will have no power of decision.
4. The Liaison Officer will divide his time between Washington, Paris, and such other places as appropriate to the accomplishment of his mission.
5. The Liaison Officer will present to the Standing Group, either personally or by dispatch, problems involving military considerations on which the TCC (SCC) desire guidance.
6. Staff and secretarial assistance will be provided to the Liaison Officer by the Standing Group from time to time, on request, in order to assist him in the dispatch of his duties.
