MEMORANDUM FOR THE NORWEGIAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Time-Phased Allocation of Canadian No. 4
Mark VI Radars to NATO Nations

Reference: Your Memorandum 1519/134. 4/51/RMS/1D
dated 18 October 1951

1. On 17 October 1951 the Standing Group was advised by the Canadian Government of the time-phased allocation of No. 4 Mk VI Radars for the period March through August 1952. This information was passed to the nations concerned in SGM-1762-51.

2. The Canadian Government has also informed the Standing Group that deliveries of radars for production after August 1952 are now expected to be:

25 per month	September 1952 through February 1953
30 per month	March 1953 through June 1953

3. The Standing Group will take cognizance of the request of the Norwegian Ministry of Defence contained in the memorandum under reference when recommending to the Canadian Government time-phased allocation of radar sets after August 1952.
