MEMORANDUM FOR THE CANADIAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Allocation of Canadian Equipment

1. Reference is made to your letter GJS 332-4-2 dated 26 February 1952.

2. It is noted that the allocation of 17 pounder (TD) anti-tank guns recommended in SGM-1317-51 will be changed so as to allocate 36 guns to Denmark and 8 guns to Italy.

3. The Standing Group recommends that the following equipment, no longer required by Italy, be allocated to Belgium:

Equipment QF 17 pr ATK (SP)	25
Cartridges QF 17 pr HE Reduced Charge	1,000
Cartridges QF 17 pr APCBC	6,970
Cartridges QF 17 pr Smoke	400

4. The Standing Group forwards this recommended allocation for the concurrence of the Canadian Government.
