MEMORANDUM FOR: THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER EUROPE  
THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER ATLANTIC

SUBJECT: Meteorological Committee Working Group on  
Weather Communications

1. The Standing Group Meteorological Committee at its 9th meeting on 21 April 1952 considered the problem of the communications requirements for the meteorological services in NATO. Associated with setting out the required communication centers, circuits, broadcasts, etc, are the requirements:

a. To coordinate on a NATO-wide basis the detailed schedules and content for the various broadcasts and networks used to provide meteorological support to the NATO forces.

b. To review periodically the list of stations making broadcasts and to suggest changes to the list where necessary in order that operational requirements shall be met to the fullest possible extent.

c. To coordinate requirements and be responsible for amendments to the Meteorological Vocabulary Code used for the transmission of meteorological plain language message and the list of key groups in the code used for identifying the contents of the bulletins transmitted.

2. To facilitate the action required in subparagraphs la, b and c above the Standing Group is establishing a S.G. Meteorological Committee Working Group on Weather Communications for the purpose of making recommendations to the Meteorological Committee on the above matters. It is considered that the Working
