MEMORANDUM FOR THE FRENCH MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Address Group Assignments for NATO Nations

1. At the time that JANAP 116(C) was being divided into service publications (ACPs 101-104), the preparing agencies had no way of determining in which ACP to list activities whose nomenclature was not indicative of the parent service. As a result, these activities were listed within the national sections of more than one publication. It was anticipated that the nations concerned would, upon receipt of the publications, review their sections and recommend the changes necessary to provide proper segregation.

2. Responsibility for the printing of ACPs 101-105 has been divided among the three U.S. services. As a result, difficulties arise when an address group or its meaning, listed in more than one publication, requires a change, deletion or reassignment. Due to the distribution methods employed by the services, no amount of coordination or scheduling will insure that printed changes to these ACPs will be available and thus be made effective concurrently unless effective dates are prescribed.

3. It is to be noted that ACPs 101-105 have been so designed as to allow the service responsible for a particular ACP to prepare a printed change thereto as required. It is highly undesirable to require that all the material contained in the printed change to an ACP be delayed by an effective date merely because of the inclusion of an address group and its meaning in another publication.

4. Accordingly, it has been determined that a command or activity together with its assigned address groups should be listed in only one encode publication.

5. It is requested that the activities listed in the enclosure be reviewed with a view to determining the specific publication in which they are to be listed.
