SUBJECT: Naval Tactical Code



1. It is hoped that such trials as can be arranged by Supreme Commanders to evaluate the proposed Naval Tactical Code should be completed by 1 July 1956. Confirmation is requested that this can be arranged, or if that date cannot be met, that an alternative be stated.

2. Supreme Commanders are also requested to inform the Standing Group Distribution and Accounting Agency Europe as soon as possible of the dates and duration of exercises in which it is intended to use the Code so that the periods of the book may be allocated to the best advantage.

3. It is requested that, in addition to rendering your report to the Standing Group on the operational value and suitability of this Code, you forward to the Standing Group Communication Security and Evaluation Agency Europe copies of all messages encrypted therein during the exercise, together with the cryptograms if possible.
