SUBJECT: Direction Finding Procedures - ACP 130(B)

References: a. NATOCOM 39 as amended by NATOCOM 40
b. NATOCOM 43

1. Attached hereto are advance copies of ACP 130(B), a revision of ACP 130(A).

2. This revision incorporates all currently approved changes to the publication.

3. ACP 130(B) is a non-registered publication bearing a dual classification of RESTRICTED/US CONFIDENTIAL Modified Handling Authorized. The Foreword to ACP 130(B) states that the publication will be made effective when directed by the Implementing Agency, and when effective, will supersede ACP 130(A). Standing Group is the Implementing Agency for NATO for this publication.

4. Bulk distribution of this change has been initiated by the U.S. Military Services through the Military Representatives in Washington. The copies furnished herewith are identical to those which will be received through bulk distribution and include the correcting USN errata sheet.



6. The European Military Communications Coordinating Committee is further requested to monitor and assist, whenever possible, the national preparation for implementation of the publication and to advise Standing Group when all European NATO Nations are ready to make this publication effective. Canadian authorities are requested to advise Standing Group when this publication is ready for implementation by Canadian forces.

7. It is desired that this revision be made effective NATO-wide as soon as possible; and, in the event that NATO-wide readiness for implementation is unduly delayed for any reason, it is requested that Standing Group be informed.
