6. Canadian Authorities are requested to advise EMCCC when Change No. 1 to ACP 113(H) has been made effective within the Canadian Military Forces.

The European Military Communications Coordinating Committee is further requested to monitor and assist, whenever possible, the national implementation of the Change and to advise all concerned when Change No. 1 to ACP 113(H) has been implemented by all NATO Nations. It is desired that this change be made effective NATO-wide as soon as possible; and in the event that NATO-wide readiness for implementation is unduly delayed for any reason, it is requested that the Standing Group be informed.
