6. Canadian authorities are requested to advise EMCCC when Change No. 6 to ACP 104(A) has been made effective within the Canadian Military Forces.

7. The European Military Communications Coordinating Committee is further requested to monitor and assist, wherever possible, the national implementation of the Change and to advise all concerned when Change No. 6 to ACP 104(A) has been implemented by all NATO Nations. It is desired that this change be made effective NATO-wide as soon as possible; and, in the event that NATO-wide implementation is unduly delayed for any reason, it is requested that Standing Group be informed.
