

of Defense of the European NATO Nations requesting that the copies furnished be used in preparing national Implementing Instructions and in initiating translation when translation is required.

6. The European Military Communications Coordinating Committee is further requested to monitor and assist, whenever possible, the national preparation for implementation of the publication and to advise the Standing Group when all European NATO Nations are ready to make this publication effective. Canadian Authorities are requested to advise the Standing Group when this publication is ready for implementation by Canadian Forces.

7. It is desired that this revision be made effective NATO-wide as soon as possible; and, in the event that NATO-wide readiness for implementation is unduly delayed for any reason, it is requested that the Standing Group be informed.
