MEMORANDUM FOR THE MILITARY REPRESENTATIVES OF DENMARK AND ITALY

SUBJECT: Canadian Mutual Aid Program
MISQ Fuzes for 90 mm AA Shells

Reference: SGM-219-53

Serial 17 of the Enclosure to SGM-219-53 allocated Shells 90 mm AA to certain countries. For various reasons it was decided that deliveries when made would consist of some complete Shells and some which would require insertion of the fuzes. A quantity of the fuzes referred to above subsequently proved to have a slight defect and the nations concerned were requested to state if acceptance of the fuzes was conditional upon them being modified before delivery. It is understood that you were prepared to accept them in an unmodified condition. 3000 unmodified fuzes which were originally allocated to Norway have now been rejected by that country and are available for re-allocation. It is requested that you inform the Standing Group if you are interested in bidding for all or some of these fuzes.
