MEMORANDUM FOR THE NORWEGIAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE

SUBJECT: Responsibility for NATO Communications-Electronics
Common Infrastructure Planning in Europe

1. Deletion of the term "Forward Scatter" was proposed by Denmark and France.

2. Forward Scatter is only one of many techniques now employed in point-to-point radio communications. If this term were to be retained in reference a, consistency would require that all other techniques used in point-to-point radio be similarly listed.

3. It should be noted that a related amendment is the addition of paragraph 2e. This is intended to cover special projects involving difficult problems.

4. In view of the above, reconsideration of the position stated in reference c is requested.
