MEMORANDUM FOR THE STANDING GROUP

SUBJECT: Procedures for Correspondence During Standing Group Stay in Paris

1. Communications originating in the Standing Group in Paris will have the following indicators:

- a. NATO Msg STAND (Paris) 1 (2, 3, etc.) from SGN.
- b. NATO Msg STASEC (Paris) 1 (2, 3, etc.) from SGN.
- c. NATO Informal Staff Planners Msg (Paris) 1 (2, 3, etc.) from SGN.

- d. SGM's. 682 through 701.
- e. SGWM's. 681 through 700.
- f. ISPMemo's. 21 through 40.
- g. I.P.T. numbers as arranged by I.P.T. Secretary.
- h. L.M.P.'s 91 through 100.
- i. S.G. numbers in series as follows:
 - (1) New numbers 250 through 260.
 - (2) Next paper on Terms of Reference would be S.G. 70/39.

2. Messages to the Standing Group in Paris will be addressed to SGLO, Paris, France with the following type heading:

"NATO Msg STASEC _____ from SGN. SGLO pass to Director S.G."

3. Captain Davis will operate a S.G. Registry in Paris. NATO documents should be routed through this registry in order that accountability can be maintained.
