1. In accordance with reference a the International Planning Team has considered the suggested allocations of call signs for Task Forces and Task Elements contained in ACP 112(A), now scheduled to be brought into force on 1 May 1956.

2. The International Planning Team agrees with the figures suggested in paragraph 4 of reference b for allocation of call signs to nations. They recommend, however, that the allocations to Major NATO Commanders be modified as follows:
