CCMS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

The Secretary General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization announced today the award of ten fellowship grants under the 1975 Fellowship Programme of the Committee on the Challenges of Modern Society (CCMS).

The fellowships are aimed at helping scholars increase their skills and knowledge in the field of natural and social environment. They are also designed to contribute to the training of promising individuals for national and international positions in fields which involve formulation of public policy.

The present awards mark the fifth successive year in which fellowships have been granted by CCMS to stimulate and encourage serious study of problems dealing with public policy in relation to natural and social environment.

Priority areas selected by the CCMS for the 1975 competition include the following topics :

- (i) Environmental impacts related to energy;
- (ii) Solid waste disposal and recycling;
- (iii) Advanced programmes for the care and well-being of older citizens;
- (iv) Selected aspects of noise pollution.

The ten grants announced today will go to scholars in nine member countries : Belgium, France, Iceland, Italy, Norway, Portugal, Turkey, the United Kingdom and the United States.

Research topics, names and nationalities of the 1975 fellows include the following :
