The North Atlantic Council will convene on the morning of 24 October to consult with U.S. Secretary of State Shultz following his visit to the Soviet Union.

This meeting will be a part of the continuing process of consultation within the alliance.

The U.S. Mission informs us that Secretary Shultz will give a news conference at the end of the meeting in the Luns Press Theatre at NATO.

ACCREDITATION

- (a) Journalists holding NATO permanent press cards need not apply for accreditation but are asked simply to check in at the accreditation desk on arrival.
- (b) Correspondents not in possession of a NATO permanent press card will be admitted to the press zone on presentation of numbered individual NATO press passes. Advance application for this accreditation may be made by filling in the enclosed forms.

NATO press passes will not be mailed to applicants. They may be collected from the accreditation desk in the press zone from 14h00 on Thursday, 22 October.

Note: NATO reserves the right to withhold press cards in cases where no advance application has been submitted.
