NATO RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS PROGRAMME 1993-1994

The North Atlantic Treaty Organization is pleased to announce the award of 84 fellowships to citizens of NATO member nations and of cooperation partner countries in Central and Eastern Europe.

The aim of these NATO fellowships is to promote research leading to publication in two distinct areas. The first type of fellowship is awarded to citizens of NATO member countries for the study of aspects of the common interests and shared values of the Alliance. This category of award targets both individual projects and institutions, the latter in the form of support for research groups. This year 20 fellowships have been granted.

The second category originates from the May 1989 NATO Summit, which decided to establish a new Fellowship Programme whose goal was to promote the study of democratic institutions. These fellowships are aimed exclusively at citizens of Central and Eastern European countries. This year 64 such fellowships have been awarded.

PROGRAMME DE BOURSES DE RECHERCHE OTAN 1993/94

L'Organisation du Traité de l'Atlantique Nord a le plaisir d'annoncer l'octroi de 84 bourses à des ressortissants de pays membres de l'OTAN et de pays partenaires de la coopération d'Europe centrale et orientale.

Ces bourses de l'OTAN ont pour objet de promouvoir des recherches aux fins de publication dans deux domaines différents. Le premier type de bourse est octroyé à des ressortissants de pays membres de l'OTAN, pour l'étude de divers éléments des intérêts et des valeurs partagés par tous les pays de l'Alliance. Cette catégorie de bourses vise à la fois des projets individuels et institutionnels, ces derniers sous forme d'une aide à des groupes de recherche. Cette année, 20 projets ont été couronnés.

La deuxième catégorie trouve son origine dans la décision, prise au Sommet de l'OTAN de mai 1989, de lancer un nouveau programme de bourses de recherche visant à promouvoir l'étude des institutions démocratiques. Ces bourses sont réservées aux ressortissants des pays d'Europe centrale et orientale. Soixante-quatre bourses de cette catégorie ont été octroyées cette année.

La composition du Comité de Sélection ainsi que les noms des boursiers de l'OTAN et leurs sujets d'étude sont indiqués en annexe.
