TO NATO ON 23 JUNE 1993

The Chairman of Parliament and Head of State of Georgia, Mr. Eduard Shevardnadze, will pay an official visit to NATO Headquarters on 23 June 1993. He will meet the Secretary General, Mr. Manfred Wörner, and address the North Atlantic Council. The visit will begin at 10:30. Mr. Shevardnadze's departure is expected at 15:00.
