**MILITARY COMMITTEE MEETING IN COOPERATION SESSION
AT CHIEF OF DEFENCE/CHIEF OF GENERAL STAFF LEVEL. 27 APRIL 1994**

Date and Place

The Military Committee in Chiefs of Staff Session, NATO's senior military authority, will hold its first formal meeting in 1994 on Tuesday, 26 April 1994.

On Wednesday, 27 April 1994 the third Military Committee Meeting in Cooperation Session at the Chief of Defence/Chief of General Staff Level with representatives of the Central and Eastern European states will be held.

Both meetings will be held at NATO Headquarters in Brussels.

Accreditation

- A. Journalists holding permanent NATO press cards need not apply for accreditation but are asked simply to check in at the accreditation desk on arrival.

- B. Correspondents not in possession of a NATO permanent press card will be admitted to the press zone on presentation of numbered individual NATO press passes. Advance application for this accreditation may be made by filling in the enclosed forms. Please return the completed forms as soon as possible to:

NATO Press passes will not be mailed to applicants. They may be collected from the accreditation desk in the press zone from 08.00 on Tuesday, 26 April 1994.

Note: NATO reserves the right to withhold press cards in cases where no advance application has been submitted.
