The Military Committee in Chiefs of Staff Session, NATO's senior military authority, will hold its first meeting in 1995 on Tuesday, 25 April 1995.

On Wednesday, 26 April 1995 the 4th Military Committee Meeting in Cooperation Session at the Chief of Defence/Chief of General Staff Level with representatives of the Central and Eastern European states will be held.

Both meetings will be held at NATO Headquarters in Brussels.
