REPORT ON VISITING GROUPS TO NATO IN 1957

Note by the Director of Information

For the information of members of the Committee on Information and Cultural Relations attached is a list of the groups which have visited NATO Headquarters in the fiscal year 1957.

The total number of such groups is 132, comprising 4574 persons. These groups breakdown as follows :

This compares with 154 groups, comprising 4636 persons in the year 1956. It should be noted, however, that NATO was able to receive groups in only 11 out of 12 months in 1957 because of the important ministerial meeting in December, 1957.

Bookings thus far in 1958 indicate a 20% increase over 1957 in numbers of groups desiring to visit NATO.
