(dated 7th November, 1956)

1. 712(a) NATO Letter

Second paragraph

Delete the sentence: "Its present circulation is 23,000 copies in English and 5,000 in French".

Third Paragraph

Delete the entire paragraph: "We still believe 14,000,000 francs" and substitute the following:

"The total circulation in 1955 amounted to 13,000 copies. During 1956 it was possible to expand this circulation to approximately 28,000 copies (23,000 in English and 5,000 in French). In view of the fact that this expansion has to a large extent been obtained through the active assistance of three or four governments, the expectation is justified that a further increase may be achieved in other countries next year. A target for the combined French and English circulation of between 40 - 45,000 copies is therefore considered reasonable. On the basis of present expenditure, this would cost approximately 14,000,000 francs. (1)"

2. 712(c) Printing Fund

Delete the existing text and substitute the following:

"712(c) Printing Fund

1957 Proposal : 7,500,000 frs.

1956 Vote : 5,000,000 frs.

"By the end of 1956 the following material will have been produced out of the printing fund : 3,500 copies of the Secretary General's Five Years Report (English, 2nd impression); 18,000 copies in English and 8,000 in French of the NATO Handbook; 10,000 copies in English and 5,000 in French of "The Trade Unions and NATO". Moreover, part of the production costs of the Popular Illustrated Pamphlet in German (30,000 copies), Italian (25,000 copies) and Turkish (15,000 copies) was financed out of this Fund.

"Besides new publications which may be required next year, it will be necessary to keep existing materials up-to-date and have them reprinted. This applies, in particular, to the NATO Handbook, a new edition of which is envisaged early next year (1) and also the brochure for Trade Unions of which a relatively small number of copies was printed this year as a start, and for which a greater demand can be expected next year.

"For these reasons, a credit of 7.5 million francs is proposed (reprint of Handbook: 2 millions; reprint of Popular Illustrated Pamphlet: 2.5 millions; reprint of Trade Union Brochure: 1 million; folder "Twenty Questions on NATO": 0.5 million; new publications and miscellaneous: 1.5 millions)."
