SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS.

Passes.

Two types of passes will be issued to members of the International Staff :

- (a) Laminated passes with a red border, which admits them to any part of the building.
- (b) Laminated passes which admit to all parts of the building except the Council Room.

These passes will be issued by the Security Officer, Mr. Hallows, in Room 18, 1st Floor of the Foro Italico.

Documents.

Steel presses will be available in Room 9 for the storage of classified documents when not in use. Room 9 is under 24-hour guard. No steel presses have been provided in individual offices and it is therefore essential that all classified material when not in use should be stored safely under the security arrangements referred to above.

Under no circumstances may classified documents be kept in hotel rooms.

All classified waste should be returned to Room 9 and placed in the receptacle provided.
