WORKING PARTY ON WARNINGS -  
COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

Note by the Secretary

The Civil Defence Committee at its meeting held on the 27th and 28th June directed that a Working Party should be set up with the following terms of reference (AC/23(CD)R/6, Item II, paragraph 51(2)):

- (a) to study the problem of warnings both for bombing attack and for radio-active fall-out;
- (b) to consist of military and civilian representatives from each country together with one representative from Headquarters AFCE and one representative from SHAPE;
- (c) to keep itself informed of the North American warning arrangements which were now being built diligently by the United States and Canada.

2. The first meeting of the Committee will be held on 28th September and it would be appreciated if member countries would notify the Secretary of the name or names of their representatives to serve on this Working Party.
