### PROPOSED REVISION OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION SECURITY SYSTEM

#### Report by the Working Group on NATO Security

1. At their meeting on Wednesday, February 6th, 1952, the Working Group on NATO Security considered the comments by the Security Coordinating Committee on the proposed amendments which it had put forward, contained in SG 7/46 from the Standing Group.

2. The Working Group noted that the Security Coordinating Committee had agreed to a substantial number of the amendments which had been recommended, but that a few points remained over which there were still divergencies of view. In order to arrive at an agreed solution as soon as possible, the Working Group agreed to request the Standing Group Liaison Officer to convey to the Security Coordinating Committee in Washington, details of the reasons on which their recommendations had been based. Any points over which complete agreement was not reached would have to be referred to the Council Deputies for decision.

3. In view of the desirability of introducing DC 2/7 into general use as soon as possible, the Working Group agreed to request the Council Deputies to give their provisional approval to all the amendments to DC 2/7 which have been approved both by the Security Coordinating Committee and the Working Group. The only points outstanding being those in SG 7/46 set out below:

- a. paragraph 3
- b. paragraph 10
- c. paragraph 11
- d. paragraph 14
- e. paragraph 17

4. The Working Group agreed to hold a further meeting after the Lisbon Conference of the North Atlantic Council to consider the further views of the Security Coordinating Committee.

5. The Working Group also decided that the question of the Security Committee in Europe should be held over until decisions had been taken about the future organization of NATO.
