DRAFT RESOLUTION NO.1

Abolition of the Council Deputies, the Defence Production Board  
and the Financial and Economic Board)

THE COUNCIL DEPUTIES,

Acting on behalf of the North Atlantic Council,

Considering the terms of paragraph 23(d) of the report on  
the reorganization of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization  
(9-D/4 Final) which was adopted by the Council Deputies on  
behalf of the North Atlantic Council on 12th March, 1952, and  
which requires the Council Deputies to fix a date on which the  
new arrangements set out in the report shall become effective  
and the new Treaty agencies shall assume their functions,

RESOLVE

(1) that the arrangements specified in that report shall  
become effective today, 4th April, 1952, whereupon the Council  
Deputies, the Defence Production Board, and the Financial and  
Economic Board cease to exist and the powers and responsibilities  
with which they were invested revert to the North Atlantic  
Council; and

(2) that any committees or working parties which may have  
been set up for specific purposes by these agencies, and which  
have not completed their tasks by today, shall continue their  
work and present their reports to the North Atlantic Council.

DRAFT RESOLUTION NO.2

(Transfer of financial powers vested in the Chairman of the Council Deputies)

## THE COUNCIL DEPUTIES

Considering the report on the reorganization of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (C9-D/4 Final) which was adopted by the Council Deputies on behalf of the North Atlantic Council on 12th March, 1952, and in particular its paragraphs 16 and 17 which provide that there shall be a Secretary-General of the Organization and which define his powers,

Considering the various financial powers which have been vested by the Council Deputies in their Chairman under D-D(51)74, Financial Regulations for Civilian Agencies,

RESOLVE that the said financial powers are hereby transferred to the Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization with effect from 4th April, 1952.
