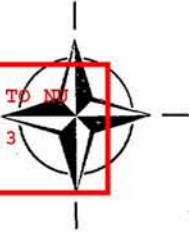

Andreas LERHEIM, Major, Norwegian Army, born 27th January 1913.
Graduated as officer in 1939.

His intelligence record is as follows:

Served before the war in the Intelligence Division of the Ministry of Defence.

From 1941 he served with the Norwegian Supreme Command in London, mostly in charge of the secret intelligence information from Norway. Appointed Chief of the Division from 1944 to 1945.

From 1947 to 1951 head of the Division for security and counter-espionage in the Intelligence Branch of the Defence Staff. Co-ordinated the security measures in the armed forces.

When the Allied Headquarters Northern Europe was established in Oslo, he served as HQ Security Officer. In 1952 transferred to the Intelligence Division of the Headquarters serving as Staff Officer/Counter Intelligence.

In 1953 assigned to national service and appointed Inspector General for Security, responsible for the implementation of the national security measures and the NATO security measures. Since 1954 served as Norwegian Representative to NATO Security Committee.

Mr. Lerheim speaks fluent English. Working knowledge of French and good knowledge of German.
