Subject: Distribution of papers emanating from
Expert Working Groups of the Production
and Logistics Division to Individual
Experts

From time to time the International Staff is invited to distribute papers produced by Expert Working Groups of the technical sections of the Production and Logistics Division direct to the individual experts by name. Though this may be convenient for the experts concerned it has led to many difficulties and complications in the past and as pointed out in a memorandum to delegations by the Assistant Secretary General for Production and Logistics in August (DLH/14) has been discontinued.

In cases where this causes particular difficulty for the individual expert concerned he should contact his delegation directly rather than the originator, or the documents office of NATO. The Production and Logistics Division will in any case keep in close contact with delegations over any changes in distribution lists arising from changes in representation in Expert Working Groups. Individual experts in the Working Groups are being advised of these arrangements directly by letter from the Secretaries of the Groups. A copy of this standard letter is attached.

Dear

For some months now the International Staff has discontinued the practice of making distributions of expert working group papers directly to individual experts by name. This is because of many difficulties and complications, principally that of security. All such distributions are made directly to your delegation. If this causes difficulty for you in obtaining your documents you should contact your delegation directly. Your delegation will in any case be kept constantly informed of the lists of experts for the various working groups so that they themselves should have no difficulty in knowing what their distribution should be.
