Arrangements for Ministerial Meeting -
Conference Rooms and Passes

A. Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place in the Council Chamber on Tuesday, 15th December, 1959 at 10.15 a.m. All members of delegations should be seated by 10.05 at the latest.

2. For this ceremony there will be four seats at the table and 16 seats behind for each delegation. Table plans will be displayed in the Salle des Pas perdus.

3. Access to the ceremony will be by means of buff coloured "opening ceremony" passes. Twenty of these are being sent to each Delegation.

B. Political Discussions

4. The political discussions will begin in Conference Room I on Tuesday, December 15th, immediately after the opening ceremony is over. They may be resumed on completion of the discussion of military items.

5. In Conference Room I there will be 2 seats at the table and 6 seats behind for each delegation.

6. Access to Sessions in Room I will be by means of special white passes. Eight of them have been sent to each delegation.

C. Plenary Session - Military Items

7. The discussion of military items in plenary session will start in the Council Chamber on Wednesday, 16th December, 1959 at 10.15 a.m.

8. For this meeting there will be four seats at the table and 16 seats behind for each delegation.
