Some initial suggestions by the U.K. Representative

We should look at practical problems and likely tasks in order to see what analysis or study has to be done, what procedures have to be followed, and what improvement is required in the mechanism of the Alliance.

There is no need to agree finally at this stage on the tasks. Let us postulate some tasks, do the studies which they require, and then see if we can confirm the definition of the tasks.

Tasks and Studies

A central task which comprehends many others:- To establish (a) what are the political and military conditions for progress towards European security, (b) how should we conduct this movement, both bilaterally within a framework of agreed policy, and multilaterally.

This task requires studies of the following matters, with an indication of the body which could carry them out or is doing so already:-

The evolution of other Eastern European states.

Sub-group of the Special Group, with experts.

Proposals for arms control and disarmament, with special reference to Europe

Another sub-group, with disarmament experts, consulting D.P.W.G. as required.

What are the conditions for the balanced reduction of forces? What reduction on each side is consistent with Western security?

Sub-group to formulate terms for a study by D.P.W.G.

Bring up to date the analysis of existing bilateral East/West contacts.
