TERM OF OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT, MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE
MEMBERS OF THE NATO APPEALS BOARD

In accordance with Articles 4.11 and 4.12 of the Regulations governing complaints and appeals (Annex IX to the Civilian Personnel Regulations), the President and members, as well as the alternate members, of the NATO Appeals Board are appointed by the North Atlantic Council for a period of three years.

2. The term of office of the President, full members and alternate members will expire on 31st December 1982.

3. Wherever possible, most international organizations do their best to avoid changing the membership of their Appeals Boards so as to profit from the incumbents' experience and ensure continuity in Boards' decisions. Moreover, the high degree of competence of the present Board has been recognized both within and outside NATO.

4. I would therefore suggest, in agreement with the delegations concerned, that the following be appointed for a further three-year period starting on 1st January 1983:

Dr. J.H. von Oertzen (Germany): President

Sir Robin Hooper (United Kingdom): Full member

Mr. M. Barton (France): Full member

Mr. F. Faina (Italy): Alternate to the President

Mrs. N. Jeanmart-Verheyden (Belgium): Alternate member

Mr. St.C. Nelson (United States): Alternate member

5. Unless objections are received from delegations before 31st December at the latest, I shall take it that the Council has approved the proposals to renew the term of office of the President, full members and alternate members of the NATO Appeals Board.
