1. Forwarded separately, this date, in accordance with paragraph 202 b of reference a, were advance copies of Change No. 2 to ACP 113(M), consisting of routine additions, deletions and changes required to bring the Call Sign Book for Ships series up to date.

distributing authorities are all that will be received unless this action is taken. The Standing Group should be advised of any such action in this regard.

3. It is desired that the advance copies be used by national authorities in arranging for national implementation, and for translation purposes, if required. The copies furnished may be forwarded to home authorities under the provisions of reference b.

4. Change No. 2 to ACP 113(M) is effective upon receipt, at which time it shall be entered in the basic ACP.

5. This memorandum will be cancelled when Change No. 2 to ACP 113(M) is implemented NATO-wide, in accordance with paragraph 4 above.
