**VISIT BY THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF ESTONIA.
MR. JURI LUIK. TO NATO ON 3 FEBRUARY 1994**

The Minister for Foreign Affairs of Estonia, Mr. Juri Luik, will come to NATO Headquarters on 3 February 1994 to sign the Partnership for Peace Framework Document. He will meet the Deputy Secretary General and the Permanent Representatives to the North Atlantic Council. The visit will begin at 10:00. Mr. Luik's departure is expected at 11:00.

- 10:15 - Room 1: North Atlantic Council Session. Introductory remarks by the Deputy Secretary General, followed by Mr. Luik's reply. Signing of Partnership for Peace Framework Document by the Estonian Minister for Foreign Affairs. Coverage within the conference room by a restricted pool.
- 10:35 - NATO main entrance. Meeting with the Press. Departure of the Estonian Minister for Foreign Affairs at about 10.45.
