STATUS OF GERMANY, DENMARK AND ITALY WITHIN THE AUTHORITY
FOR THE CO-ORDINATION OF INLAND SURFACE TRANSPORT
IN CENTRAL EUROPE (ACTICE)

Report by the Chairman of the Senior Civil Emergency
Planning Committee

1. At its last meeting held on 14th and 15th January 1957, the Senior Committee agreed to recommend to the Council that the terms of reference of ACTICE as set out in paragraph 2 of C-M(54)46 should be amended to read as follows:

"This organization, known as the authority for the Co-ordination of Inland Surface Transport in Central Europe (ACTICE), shall be composed of representatives of Belgium, the United States, France, the Federal Republic of Germany, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom, and of the representative of the Allied Military Authority, appointed by SACEUR. Italy and Denmark shall also send representatives to ACTICE as observers."(1)

2. Germany has in fact already exercised the rights of membership of ACTICE for some time. The representation of Denmark and Italy by observers is justified by their permanent surface transport exchanges with France and Germany.

3. The Council is invited to amend the terms of reference of ACTICE as suggested in paragraph 1 above.
