PROPOSAL BY THE PORTUGUESE DEPUTY CONCERNING  
COST-SHARING OF ALL HEADQUARTERS

Note by the Executive Secretary

In the course of the Council Deputies discussion on 17th December, 1952 on the method of sharing the cost of SACLANT Headquarters, the Portuguese Deputy made a proposal concerning the principle to be applied to sharing the costs of all headquarters (D-R(51)89, Item IX, paragraph 22). He also circulated a paper, which is reproduced below, giving figures prepared on the basis of his proposal:
