TEXT OF NOTE BY THE BELGIAN GOVERNMENT

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Embassy of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics(1) that the members of the USSR Embassy(1), their families, and USSR(1) nationals who hold a special residence permit or certificate in lieu thereof, are requested to notify the Protocol Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1st April 1952 onwards of any journey which they intend to make outside the limits of the Province of Brabant.

In order that the Protocol Department may issue the necessary authorisation in time, notification should be made at least 48 hours before the date of the journey. The notification should give the name and rank of the persons making the journey, the method of transport to be used, the proposed destination, the route to be followed, and the duration of the journey.
