REORGANIZATION OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION

The attached draft, concerning the transfer from the Chairman of the Council Deputies to the Secretary-General of the Organization, of the powers at present exercised by the Chairman of the Council Deputies in connection with (1) the Agreement on the Status of National Representatives and International Staff, and (2) the Agreement between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces, is circulated for the consideration of the Council Deputies.

DRAFT NOTIFICATION

to the Governments by the Council Deputies regarding the North Atlantic Treaty Organization Agreement on the Status of National Representatives and International Staff, and the Agreement between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces.

The Council Deputies request their Chairman to inform the Governments of resolutions _____ and _____ (1) which provide that the powers of the Council Deputies shall revert to the Council on 4th April 1952 and that the powers of the Chairman of the Council Deputies shall be assumed by the Secretary-General of the Organization on 4th April 1952.

It appears to the Council Deputies that the powers to be exercised by their Chairman in connection with (1) the Agreement on the Status of National Representatives and International Staff, signed at Ottawa the 20th September, 1951, and (2) the Agreement between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces, signed at London the 19th June 1951, should, from the effective dates mentioned above, be exercised by the Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization.

The Council Deputies request their Chairman to enquire if the Governments would signify, at their earliest convenience, their concurrence with this interpretation of the Agreement in question.
