DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE 1956 ANNUAL REVIEW

THE NORTH ATLANTIC COUNCIL:

HAVING CONSIDERED the Report on the 1956 Annual Review and the Comments<sup>(1)</sup> of the Military Committee thereon, and having noted that the review has been directed, in particular, towards the indication of limited but practical improvements which can be worked into each country's defence programme over the period 1957 to 1959, and which will retain their validity whatever changes may be decided,

1. ADOPTS the force plans set out in Annex II of each Country Study (as modified by addenda and corrigenda thereto) and summarised in the summary force tables in document C-M(56)..., as agreed firm goals for 1957, provisional goals for 1958, and planning goals for 1959;
2. URGES Governments which have been unable to submit force plans for 1958 and 1959 to do so at the earliest possible date;
3. URGES Governments individually and collectively to give serious consideration to the recommendations in their Country Chapters, to meet their commitments with respect to the 1957 goals, and to take all steps in their power to attain the goals for 1958 and 1959.
